A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL DRAIN FUND  
TO THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, for many years the Commissioners had allocated a portion of their annual budget for an advance to the General Drain Fund; and

WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Surveyor has purchased GPS equipment for his staff to use while working out in the field; and

WHEREAS, the field equipment was purchased from the Surveyor's budget within the County General Fund; and

WHEREAS, Indiana statute allows the transfer of General Drain Advance by County monies to the County General Fund for the cost of equipment that cannot be assigned to a particular drain.


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the DeKalb County Council to transfer an amount not to exceed \$25,000 from the General Drain Fund #1158 to County General Fund #1001 for the purchase of the field equipment.






