Order Granting Additional Senior Judge Service Days

On January 6, 2025, this Court issued an Order establishing senior judge service days for calendar year 2025. Subsequently, the Honorable Adam Squiller, Judge of the DeKalb Superior Court, submitted a request for additional days.

And this Court, being duly advised, now finds that Judge Squiller has established sufficient reasons for the allotment of additional senior judge service days to his court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the number of senior judge service days allotted to the DeKalb Superior Court for calendar year 2025 is increased by 15 days.

It is the responsibility of the presiding judge of the court to ensure that the number of senior judge service days allotted is not exceeded during the calendar year.
