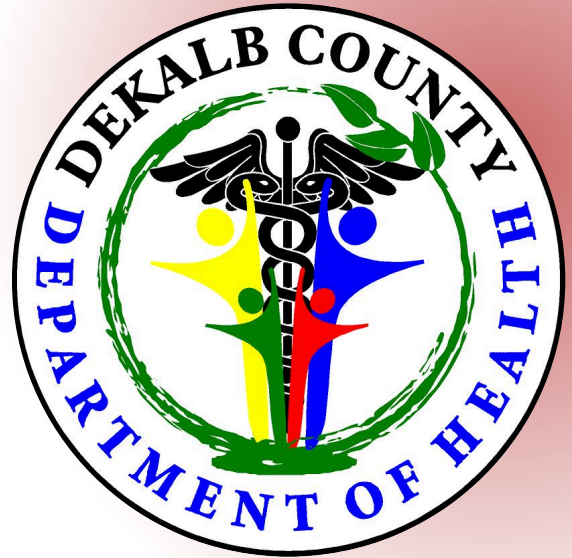

Measles Vaccine Clinic

Thursday, April 3, 2025 from 1:00pm - 6:00pm
Appointments are required.

- The measles vaccine is available to all children ages 1 year and older regardless of insurance status. We also offer to any adults born during 1957 or after. Adults needing the vaccine will need to provide insurance during their appointment time.

ABOUT THE MEASLES



Easily Spread

Spread through droplets in the air after an infected person coughs or sneezes. It can also be spread through contact with objects that have been in contact with infected droplets.



Highly Contagious

9 out of 10 unvaccinated individuals will become infected if exposed. This is due to the viruses ability to survive in the air for up to 2 hours.



Full Vaccination Status

2 doses of the MMR vaccine spaced at least 28 days apart. 2 doses of the measles vaccine are about 97% effective of preventing measles if exposed to the virus.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY SCHOOL AGE CHILD IS EXPOSED TO MEASLES?

If school age children who are not fully vaccinated against measles are exposed to an individual with the measles virus they will be required to quarantine for 21 days with each exposure.
